	and 27 % Latinx/ Hispanic. Data collection is going well, and			
	evaluation is ongoing. Outcomes are to improve mental			
	health (Stress, Depression and Wellness); physical health,			
	healthy lifestyles, financial stability, father involvement,			
	social networking and longer term outcomes for Mom and			
	Baby. Present work is to have more alignment with national			
	measures where possible. For example, healthy birth weight, full term pregnancy, decrease of birth complications for			
	mom and baby, physical health of mother and baby,			
	initiation of breastfeeding, Healthy Days questions and
